TERMS

- 1. Permission.** For the fee above, the Owner lets the Producer, its cast, crew, vehicles and equipment enter and use the areas listed on the dates listed, to prepare, film and wrap.
- 2. Use of footage.** The Producer may film the property, including its interiors, exteriors, signs and address, and use the footage in the Production and its advertising, in any media now known or later developed, worldwide, forever. The Producer does not have to name the real property.
- 3. Care of the property.** The Producer may make temporary changes, such as set dressing, and will remove them. It will leave the property as it found it, apart from normal wear, and will pay for any damage its cast or crew cause.
- 4. Insurance.** The Producer will show proof of liability insurance if the Owner asks for it.
- 5. Authority.** The Owner owns or controls the property and can give this permission without anyone else's consent.
- 6. Release.** The Owner releases the Producer from claims about filming the property and using the footage as allowed here.
