THE 8-POINT FORMULA

1. PLOT SUMMARY the setup in 2 or 3 sentences, no spoilers	2. ACTING AND DIRECTION who stands out, and the choices behind it
3. THEMES what the film is really about	4. SOUND AND VISUALS score, cinematography, editing, design
5. PACING where it flies, where it drags	6. SPECIFIC EXAMPLES scenes, shots or lines that prove your points
7. DESCRIPTIVE WORDS 5 words that capture how it feels	8. RECOMMENDATION who should watch it, and why

Outline your review, then write it

HEADLINE

TARGET WORD COUNT

REVIEW OUTLINE

INTRODUCTION

hook, film details, your verdict in one sentence

BODY PARAGRAPH 1

your strongest point, with an example

BODY PARAGRAPH 2

second point, with an example

BODY PARAGRAPH 3

what didn't work, or a third point

CONCLUSION

restate the verdict, then recommend

BEFORE YOU HAND IT IN

- ☐ Title, year and director in the first paragraph
- ☐ At least 3 specific scenes, shots or lines
- ☐ Acting, direction, sound and visuals all covered
- ☐ Present tense for what happens on screen
- ☐ A clear verdict before the end of the intro
- ☐ No spoilers past the first act (or a warning)
- ☐ A recommendation: who should watch it
- ☐ Read it out loud once before you hand it in
